

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**RESOLUTION NO. 761 (#14 – 2017)**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND GRANTING AUTHORIZATION TO MAYOR FLETCHER AND POLICE DIRECTOR BAMBURG FOR APPROVAL AND AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT AND MEMO OF UNDERSTANDING FOR THE PULASKI COUNTY CRISIS STABILIZATION UNIT; AND, FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

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*WHEREAS*, treatment of mental health patients in jail facilities has reached epidemic proportions throughout the United States, with millions facing incarceration for actions taken because of mental health diseases and/or concurring substance abuse problems; and,

*WHEREAS*, in an attempt to better provide for mental health patients entering the Criminal Justice system, Pulaski County has sought approval for and has dedicated One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for development of an appropriate Regional Crisis Stabilization Unit to help mental health patients and/or concurring substance abuse violators find alternative solutions to incarceration. Pulaski County has requested that all cities within the County join in the costs of providing such through a daily user fee in compliance with the Arkansas Criminal Justice Efficiency and Safety Act. To do so, there will be an Interlocal Agreement and Memo of Understanding for Mayor Fletcher and Police Director Bamburg to execute after consideration and negotiation.

***NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, ARKANSAS, THAT:***

***SECTION ONE:*** The Mayor, City Clerk, and Police Director Bamburg are hereby authorized on behalf of the City to execute any and all necessary documents for participation of the City of Jacksonville with the Pulaski County Crisis Stabilization Unit. The City Council recognizes and agrees that doing so will, hopefully, benefit Jacksonville citizens struggling with mental health diseases and/or concurring substance abuse for better and long-term solutions to their outstanding criminal problems rather than reoccurrence of incarceration created by the vicious cycles in which some members of our Community find themselves.

The Council hereby authorizes Mayor Fletcher, City Clerk Davitt, and Police Director Bamburg to negotiate, execute, and complete the appropriate Interlocal Agreement and Memo of Understanding so that Jacksonville citizens who need such can participate in the County's Regional Crisis Stabilization Unit in the future. Though the problems associated with them are epidemic in proportion, Mayor Fletcher and Director Bamburg have

proposed Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) for funding for this program during 2018 and will address future funding in the annual Budget approved by this Council.

**SECTION TWO:** The Mayor, City Clerk, and Director Bamburg are hereby authorized and directed to execute all appropriate agreements and contracts necessary to approve the Interlocal Agreement and the Memo of Understanding as required by Pulaski County.

**SECTION THREE:** This Resolution, being necessary for the betterment of the public utility and in the continuing purpose of protecting the public's health and safety, shall be in effect from and after its date of adoption.

**SECTION FOUR:** Any other Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of said conflict. This Resolution shall be in effect from and after its date of passage.

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**ORDINANCE NO. 1575 (#11 - 2017)**

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND CERTIFYING TAX LIENS AGAINST REAL PROPERTIES AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS WITHIN THE CITY FOR BALANCES DUE FROM SERVICES RENDERED BY AND/OR ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, ARKANSAS; AND, FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

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*WHEREAS*, due to violations of various municipal codes, the City of Jacksonville has expended funds for services rendered and/or performed by and/or on behalf of the City of Jacksonville for certain work on real properties located within the City limits to remove/modify various non-compliant conditions. A list of said property owners, parcel numbers, property addresses, and amounts owed are attached hereto and incorporated herewith as Exhibit A;

*WHEREAS*, despite extensive notices and repeated demands, said property owners have not paid the amounts due the City for services rendered and/or performed as detailed on Exhibit A; and,

*WHEREAS*, pursuant to Arkansas law, tax liens should be created and certified for these real properties and record property owners listed on Exhibit A. Further, the lien amounts should be certified for inclusion in the annual real estate tax statements prepared by the Pulaski County Treasurer's Office until paid in full.

***NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, ARKANSAS:***

***SECTION ONE:*** In accordance with the authority granted under ACA §14-54-904, the Jacksonville City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and/or the City Clerk to certify the list of real properties and record property owners included on the attached Exhibit A to the Pulaski County Treasurer's Office for inclusion as tax liens on annual real property tax statements for 2017.

***SECTION TWO:*** Should any part(s) of this Ordinance be declared invalid for any reason, no other part(s) of the Ordinance shall be affected thereby.

***SECTION THREE:*** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

***SECTION FOUR:*** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication, as provided by and subject to the requirements of applicable law.
