Jacksonville City Hall will reopen to the public with limited hours starting Monday, June 1. City Hall has been closed to the general public since March 18. The building will be open to the public from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. Monday-Thursday.

Visitors will be screened at the front door. Masks are recommended, but not required. The public will be asked to follow CDC guidelines with social distancing. People entering the building will also be asked if they've had:

- Recent fever of 100.4 or higher
- Recent pneumonia, cough, shortness of breath, or other covid-19 symptoms
- In the past two weeks, travel overseas or to states and metropolitan areas considered to be hot spots for the disease.
- In the past two weeks, contact with anyone who has had the disease.

Jacksonville Police Department will also open to the public 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. Monday-Thursday & the Jacksonville Animal Shelter will open 9 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday-Friday.
