## CENTER RULES

*Please go over these rules with your youth before they come to the center:*

1. If a game, ball, or any other equipment is checked out, the youth is responsible to return it in good condition or will be asked to replace the damaged or lost equipment.
2. NO FOUL LANGUAGE OR MUSIC!
3. DO NOT SIT OR LEAN ON TABLES.
4. Phones are available to call home for rides or for emergencies.
5. No outward signs of gang or group affiliation.
6. Ball caps/visors worn to front only.
7. No do-rags, bandanas, or sagging.
9. Shirts must be worn inside the building. Appropriate attire required.
10. SUSPENSIONS include the Martin Street Youth Center, Community Center, outside basketball court, Splash Zone, Skate Park and all other park facilities.



## AGE REQUIREMENTS

Ages 8 to 15 allowed in center to play ONLY with an Equipment Card completed by a parent or guardian.

Ages 16 & 17 allowed in center at 4:00pm ONLY with a photo I.D. or Equipment Card

Ages 8 to 17 allowed in center with the above requirements.

NOTE: Family members age 18 & above are welcomed and encouraged to play games with their children. Adults are not allowed to play each other.
