Jacksonville Police Department COVID-19

As a Result of the ongoing health concerns, effective today, March 17, 2020, the Jacksonville Police Department will be limiting access into the building by the general public. Police Department employees will still be working and available by phone and email. This measure is to limit exposure to our officers and civilian personnel from anyone that has been exposed or is ill and to also protect the public from officers that may have been in contact with a person that may have been exposed or ill.

As normal, our officers will still respond to emergency situations and traffic accidents. If you have an emergency situation call 911 and officers will be dispatched.
